# UEL Newsletter

## ComCast Issues

## Fire Safety and Preparedness

Although we hope to never have a fire here at UEL, it is still important that we are all aware of what to do in case of one! Take a look at the list below and make sure you know how to protect yourself against fire:

- Regularly clean out the lint collector in the dryer. Lint is highly flammable.
- Monitor your food while you are cooking. Don't leave food on the stove or in the oven while you take a nap or leave.
- Make sure all electrical cords are in good condition and not stretched across walkways.
- All escape routes (doorways and windows) are clear and free of clutter at all times.
- Keep flammable items away from open stovetop flames.
- Report to the office or your RA if your smoke detector is beeping as this usually means your battery is low.
- Remember that candles and personal BBQ grills are not allowed at UEL.
- If a building alarm goes off please make sure to exit the building as quickly as possible. No residents or staff members are allowed within the building until the fire alarm has stopped and been cleared by the necessary authorities.

**Lastly, if there is a building evacuation we will all meet behind Hoppy's Brewery and Restaurant parking lot. TheRAs will do a head count and report to office staff if there are any missing persons.**

## Having maintenance issues?

Remember that if there is anything wrong with your room (lightbulb burnt out, sink leaking, smoke detector beeping, garbage disposal not working, etc.) that you can place a work order and maintenance will take care of it! Speaking of maintenance, Resident Advisors and office staff will be doing **inspections** during the month of October. Your RA will be posting the dates your floor will be inspected. These are Health and Safety inspections so we will be looking for any health, safety or fire hazards so make sure you aren't blocking any exits with clothes, curtains or cords. Also make sure you have cleaned your tub, toilet and sinks of mildew (ew, why are you growing mildew?!).
