Move in Day this year is August 26<sup>th</sup>. We are requesting that you move in according to the Resident Advisor (RA) you have been assigned.

**We will NEVER change roommate assignments based on race, national origin, religious or political affiliations, sexual orientation, or disability.**

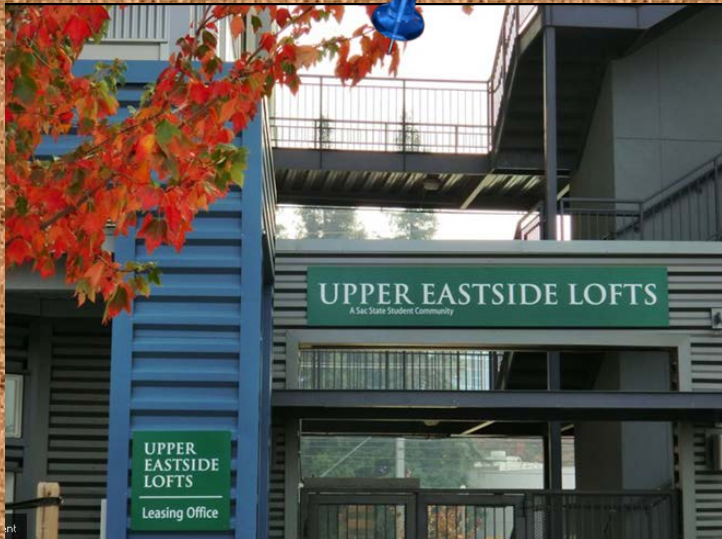
## Other important Move In Day information:
