Hello! We are extremely excited about you living at Upper Eastside Lofts!

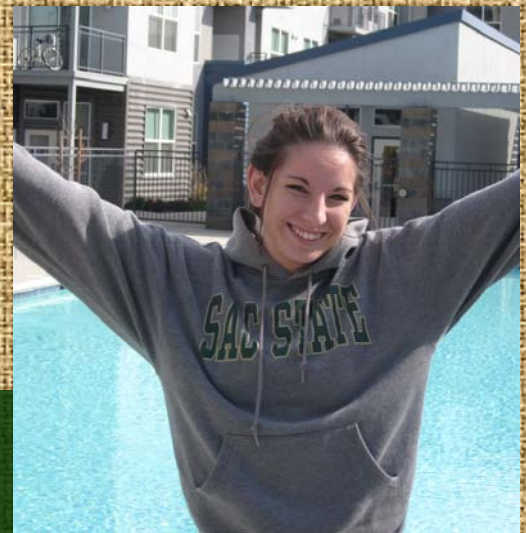
This newsletter includes everything you need to know to prepare you for Move-In Day; so, make sure you take the time to READ ALL the information.
